Concert Dress

Women wear **ankle-length black skirt, black hosiery and shoes** and long-sleeved **pure white blouse**. Men wear **black slacks, black shoes** and a long-sleeved **pure white shirt** with a **black bowtie**.

Music Policy

Unfortunately, over the years, we've lost a lot of music by people coming to a few rehearsals, collecting music, and then dropping out. Other than all of you, our music is our most valuable asset, and we have to treat it that way. So, there is a **\$10 music deposit**. Once you've paid, you can take your music home with you.

Bring a **pencil** to rehearsals to make notes in your music. **Never, ever use a pen**. Before you hand your music back in, please erase your marks so the next person will have a clean piece of music.

Dues

\$50 per concert for all members. Our treasurer will collect dues (and the \$10 music deposit, if applicable).
